Assessment Outline

<u>Task Description</u>-Both Part A and Part B will be completed in class. Students are allowed to bring an A4 sheet of notes to complete the task in class.

Part A: Identifying differing Aboriginal nations and cultural expressions.

Using the sources provided in class and your own knowledge students will be assessed on an existing cultural expression/ celebration and or signification date for Aboriginal People such as;

- Yabun
- Saltwater/Freshwater
- Coming of the Light
- NAIDOC week
- NSW Koori Rugby League Knockout
- National Sorry day
- Mabo Day
- National Reconciliation Week

Part B: You have been employed by the local council to create a cultural event/ celebration within the community.

Your plan must incorporate

- Aboriginal nations involved
- Overview of where and when the event will take place
- Overview of the event and its significance i.e. to raise cultural awareness, land rights, community coming together etc
- An agenda/ overview of activities and what will be needed for the event. i.e sports fields, function room, art supplies etc.

Students will use scaffold provided on the day of the assessment.

Outcomes to be Assessed
