### TASK DESCRIPTION

In class exam using stimulus material.

Time given: 50 minutes

1. Multiple choice – terms, skills (Interpreting Graphs, latitude and longitude, Area Reference, Grid Reference, Scale, Gradient, distance) and use of stimulus material.

2. Short Response – Human Wellbeing and Environmental Change and Management
