Assessment Outline

In Week 10 you will complete an in-class Examination for English. This exam is organised as follows:

Section 1:

Multiple Choice questions (15 marks)

- You will observe TWO unseen images relating to the topic of Endurance and Resilience.
- You will be assessed on your knowledge of the visual techniques, their effects, and the meanings they convey.

Section 2: Extended Response (10 marks)

- You will write an extended response which requires you to explore an idea or ideas you have encountered in either:
 - any images studied in the Endurance and Resilience Unit this term, or
 - the two provided images in the exam.
 - The response is to be structured in a PEEL format.
- Scaffolds to assist with your response may be available at your teachers' discretion.

PREPARING FOR YOUR EXAMINATION:

- Review your study of the Endurance and Resilience Unit. Be familiar with the following:
 - images from various texts studied
 - ideas within these texts
 - visual techniques within these images
 - the ways in which the visual techniques were used to convey the ideas
 - Practise your writing skills with attention to:
- use of appropriate punctuation
 - use of full sentences
 - use of appropriate paragraph structure
 - revision of PEEL paragraphs (Position/ Point, Evidence, Explanation, Link)
 - revision of language of comparison eg. 'on the other hand', 'whereas', 'similarly' etc
 - revision of language of opinion eg. 'I believe', 'I think', 'I realise'

Non-completion of Task:

If you know you are going to be away on the day that the exam is scheduled, you must make alternative arrangements with your teacher beforehand. If you are suddenly away on the day of the exam, you must contact your teacher or Head Teacher on your return to school.
