#### Task Description

Students will complete an exam during week 5. The exam will consist of two parts:

\* **PartA**- which will involve the analysis and use of a **Stimulus Sheet** and involve the application of geographical skills and the analysis or interpretation of graphs or text material.

**Skills covered in Part A** - research methodologies, area references, key / legend reading, scale, relief, direction, distance, types of maps, types of photographs, latitude & longitude, analysis of information.

\* **PartB** - links to the topics studied in class which cover the following:

**Water in the World** - Students need to revise the content of relating to the hydrological processes and forces that assist in the availability of and distribution of water throughout the world. Students also need to revise their **HYDROLOGICAL HAZARD** studied in class from Term 3.

**Interconnections** - Students need to be aware of the ways in which countries, people and places throughout the world are or can be can form interconnections. Knowledge of case studies may be needed.

- **Absences:** If you know you are going to be away on the day that the task is due, you must make alternative arrangements with your teacher beforehand. If you are suddenly away on the day that the task is due, you must contact your teacher or Head Teacher on your return to school. Documentation will be required in both cases
