### Task Description:

#### Part 1: In-Class Listening & Reading Assessment (20%)

Students will listen to and read texts in Japanese, giving answers in English. There will be a particular focus on the **School Life** topic, however texts may reference vocabulary and grammar from prior topics, including topics from Year 8 Japanese.

#### Part 2: Oral Interview (10%)

Students will complete a 1:1 oral interview with another peer, in-front of their teacher (or alternatively, with their teacher). They will answer set questions in a set order, some of which will be their personal response, and some which will be based off an unseen school timetable.

Students will be made familiar with the format of the oral interview leading up to the lesson. All questions, and sample responses are available inside this info pack.
