BODY OF WORK:

Create a photographic artwork that is inspired by David Hockney's Joiners. Examples of this can be found on the Google Classroom.

Your work should also demonstrate a solid understanding of the **elements of photography** and demonstrate your awareness of the **structural frame.**

Your work should be approx. A3 in size.

JOURNAL:

White journal/Black journal: must have all work completed in class this term, refer to the list on the Google Classroom. All experimental photographic work for Term 1 must be printed off and stuck in your journal. All Journal work needs to be photographed and uploaded to the Google Classroom for marking.

Non-completion of Task:

If you know you are going to be away on the day that the task is due, you must make alternative arrangements with your teacher beforehand. If you are suddenly away on the day that the task is due, you must contact your teacher or Head Teacher on your return to school. Documentation will be required in both classes.
