Assessment Outline

In-class Test:

This term you have been exploring various texts which convey minority perspectives.

This test will include two unseen texts which focus on minority experiences. In the first section of the test, you will use comprehension and analytical skills to respond to questions that require a short answer. In the second section of the test, you will write an extended analysis in response to at least one of the texts. Your response will be structured as a mini-essay.

The examination will be completed in class during your regular English lesson on Thursday 14th March.

In preparation for the examination, you should revise:

Metalinguage related to the analysis of written and visual texts

Appropriate structure for an analytical extended response (eg. PETAL, SATEEL)

Vocabulary related to minority experiences

Non-completion of Task:

Failure to complete the task on the due date will result in mark penalties or a zero if not complete within five days. Extensions must be arranged with the Head Teacher in advance.
