- c) What forms of mechanisation are used by the organisation to achieve the end products
- d) Name at least TWO recent developments within this organisation or company
 - (i) Describe in detail EACH development
 - (ii) Identify the important reasons behind the developments
 - (iii) Discuss the impact of ONE development on any or all of the other sectors of the food industry
- e) Describe any environmental considerations, policies or procedures that the organisation has in place to ensure environmental sustainability and/or awareness.

NB. Diagrams, charts, tables or illustrations should be included where appropriate.
