Assessment Outline

Students should conduct their own research and prepare one A4, single sided page of research notes.

During 45 minutes of class time on the 13th December 2019, students complete an extended response.

The question for the extended response will be based on the syllabus point:

- the social costs and benefits of nonconformity for both individuals and the wider society

Students should have several examples ready to include in their written response, including at least one from the focus study (The Twelve Tribes Community).

Non-completion of Task:

If you know you are going to be away on the day that the task is due, you must make alternative arrangements with your teacher beforehand. If you are suddenly away on the day that the task is due, you must contact your teacher or Head Teacher on your return to school. Documentation will be required in both classes.

Plagiarism:

Identifies some of the concepts of Society and Culture and exhibits some understanding of those concepts within the written piece.	5 - 8
Presents a basic response that presents a simple outline of the topic and its relation to the Society and Culture concepts. Reflects on minimal examples and how they relate. Identifies a few of the fundamental concepts of society and culture and exhibits a basic understanding of those concepts within the written piece.	1 - 4
