# Assessment Outline

This assessment consists of two parts. Both sections are to be completed by, and on, the week starting Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019.

<u>Part One</u>: To be completed at home and submitted during the students' first English class in Week 10 starting Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2019

• Students are to compose a visual representation of the notion of belonging or not belonging.

# Part Two: To be completed during the students' first English class in Week 10 starting Monday 1st April, 2019

• Students will be required to compose a written reflection (in class 1/4/19) explaining which elements of belonging/ not belonging they have included in their visual reflection and why. The reflection must also include a discussion of *at least three visual techniques* they have used and *the effect the techniques achieved in representing the notion of belonging/ not belonging.* 

## Non-completion of Task:

If you know you are going to be away on the day that the task is due, you must make alternative arrangements with your teacher beforehand. If you are suddenly away on the day that the task is due, you must contact your teacher or Head Teacher on your return to school. Documentation will be required in both classes.

## Plagiarism:
