Part 1. Information section to allow the test to be collated

Part 2. Multiple Choice and Short Answer to be completed electronically online

Comprised of true/ false questions, multiple-choice questions and drop-down short answer questions.

Part 3. Extended response questions. Questions will require a more comprehensive response and students will be required to answer questions using a structure discussed in lessons.

Questions can be asked on any of the below topic areas.

Living World Topic - how organisms are classified, similarities and difference in living things, using classification keys, structures that show different groups of living organisms, the reason for some adaptations in organisms, the structure of cells and parts of cells, different tissues, organs and systems in animals, the structure and function of different tissues in plants.

Physical World Topic – forces and how they make objects move, unbalanced forces and how they make object move, friction and the effects of friction on objects, size and direction of forces, technologies that reduce the impact of forces

Non-completion of Task:
