Assessment Outline

Students are required to compete 3 assessment items for this assessment task.

The three components are:

1. Participation in Design workshops. (10 marks)

- Students actively participate in workshops involving the development of techniques that **may include:** applique, chenilling, stencilling, tie dyeing, heliographics, transfers, textiles, dot painting, and monotyping.
- Students use samples to create a textiles item.
- Students document all workshops in their Design Portfolio.

2. Construction of Drawstring Bag. (20 marks)

- Students follow the design process to construct a drawstring bag.
- Students use appropriate textiles techniques and surface embellishments in the completion of the bag. Embellishments can include surface decorations, buttons, zippers, pockets etc.
- Students to research and develop a design for the bag, documenting the steps in the Design Portfolio.

3. Design Portfolio.(20 marks)

- Students develop a Google site and use this to document all steps in the construction of textiles items.
- Students develop Google sites with the headings: Identifying/Analysing; Researching; Generating Ideas; Producing Solutions; Evaluating.

Non-completion of Task:
