Task Description:

Prepare a word processed report that examines **TWO** of the following issues in detail. Your report should be presented on A4 paper in a display folder. Relevant illustrations should also be included. You must gather your information from at least 3 sources (eg book, internet site, Department of Health pamphlet etc). The report should be 750-1,000 words.

Select **TWO** of the following issues which may directly or indirectly harm the developing infant during pregnancy:

- Alcohol
- Tobacco
- Caffeine
- Prescription Drugs and other medication
- Illegal Drugs
- X-Ray
- Poisonous chemicals
- Rubella (German measles)
- Chicken pox
- Animal-borne diseases
- Listeriosis
- HIV / AIDS

For TWO of the issues listed above, answer the following questions :

1. Name the issue you have selected
2. Discuss in detail the symptoms and causes at various stages of the infant's growth – embryonic period and foetal period
3. Describe how the baby may be affected in any of the following areas: Emotionally, Physically, Intellectually (cognitively), or Socially.

Non-completion of Task:

If you know you are going to be away on the day that the task is due, you must make alternative arrangements with your teacher beforehand. If you are suddenly away on the day that the task is due, you must contact your teacher or Head Teacher on your return to school. Documentation will be required in both classes.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - author name - title of the publication (and the title of the article if it's a magazine or encyclopaedia) - date of publication - the place of publication of a book - the publishing company of a book - the volume number of a magazine or printed encyclopaedia - the page number(s) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - author and editor names (if available) - title of the page (if available) - the company or organization who posted the webpage - the Web address for the page (called a URL) - the last date you looked at the page

HOW TO SHOW EVIDENCE OF YOUR RESEARCH IN YOUR RESPONSE

For example: In the following, if you have referred to the AIHW and Health NSW, list them in your bibliography as -

1. AIHW
2. Health NSW

Then in your response, refer to them specifically as
