  - Select two specific needs and explain how goal setting can contribute to the satisfaction of that need. **(6 marks)**
  - Describe 3 resources needed by the community and explain how they assist in satisfying specific needs. **(6 marks)**
  - Propose 2 resources that could be interchanged to enhance the wellbeing of the community. **(6 marks)**
  - Outline 2 areas of support that can contribute the satisfaction of needs for community members. **(4 marks)**

## Part B: Extended response questions (24 marks)

You will need to attend an in class exam starting at 8am in the TFC to complete this section. You are required to answer 3 extended response questions reflecting on the below statement:

*In recent weeks NSW has been devastated by fires. This has had a significant effect on our local and rural communities, farming industry, businesses and wildlife. Many people from around the world have shown their support in a number of ways through donations and ongoing support for our fire fighters, volunteers and those who have been directly affected.*

1. Analyse how the NSW Bushfires have impacted on the wellbeing of those affected **(10 marks)**.
2. Describe the specific resources needed to rebuild a local community affected and outline how these resources will assist in satisfying the specific needs of the community **(8 marks)**.
3. Assess how personal management skills can influence resource management of those affected by the bushfires **(6 marks)**.
