Task overview:

Cities of Vesuvius – Pompeii and Herculaneum

Students are to choose **TWO** particular sites relevant to the course.

They may choose an option from the supplied list, or negotiate a site with their teacher.

They are to research this site to address in a report format the following questions:

- 1. What does this site reveal about life in Pompeii and/or Herculaneum? Use the language from the syllabus!**
- 2. Are there any works or specific projects underway to preserve/conservate this site?**
- 3. Connect any of the following aspects of the syllabus to your site:**
 - changing archaeological methods
 - new research and technological advancements
 - Italian and International contributions
 - Ethics

Outcomes assessed:

- *The influence of Greek and Egyptian cultures on art and architecture*
- *The influences of Greek and Egyptian cultures on religion*
- *Religious beliefs and practices*
