LIBRARY INFORMATION

All students at Orange High School are privileged to have use of the library as a learning/resource centre. This means that all students should be aware of the rights of others in regard to their behaviour in the library.

The library is open for use from 8.30am Monday to Friday as well as recess and lunchtime every day. Students have access to the photocopier and computers for word processing and internet use.

Borrowing Books

- The library operates on a barcode system and to borrow, you simply hand your book to a member of staff at the front desk.
- Students are able to borrow (at any one time):
 - ❖ 3 Fiction and 3 Non-Fiction books (Years 7 & 8)
 - ❖ 5 Fiction and 5 Non-Fiction books (Years 9 & 10)
 - ❖ 6 Fiction and 6 Non-Fiction books (Years 11 & 12)
- Students may borrow books for two weeks, other resources may only be used in the library.

ePlatform – eBook Lending Facility

Orange High School library has an ePlatform available to the entire Orange High School community. Our ePlatform allows students to borrow and read eBooks from the library anywhere, anytime on multiple devices such as tablets, smartphones and computers. The wide range of books includes; fiction, non-fiction and classics. Orange High School students will register online to use this fantastic resource during their library lesson
