BODY OF WORK:

You are to create a body of photographic work that is all about you. The photos taken should reflect you and will be focused around the themes of face, place and things or objects. Remember the place photos and the objects taken for things must reflect something about you. The face component needs to be a self-portrait. You will then use 3D techniques and elements to create a "photographic sculpture". Your work should also demonstrate a solid understanding of the elements of photography and demonstrate your awareness of the structural frame. (The sculptural element will be completed depending on if students return to school before end of term)
