### Project Proposal- Ten Marks

#### The Proposal should contain:

- 1. Description of preliminary research (What do you want to research and what do you know already?)
- 2. A Focus question (*Thesis*)
- 3. Enquiry questions: *Three* to *Five* questions that you will use in your methodology (*These should be drawn from the Key Questions in the syllabus*)
- 4. Research intentions in relation to:
  - a. Areas/texts to examine (Where will you look for information?)
  - b. Methodology- A brief, draft outline of when you anticipate working on each of the components of the project (*term by term in table format*)

#### Process Log-Ten Marks

#### The Process Log should contain;

• Descriptions of your research: dates and times of readings, information found in relation to your topic, types of sources (primary, secondary), evaluation of sources (useful, reliable), *When in doubt use the scaffold!* 

#### **Annotated Sources-Ten Marks**

1. Select the three to five sources used in the history project

2. Do not exceed 600 words in total

3. Explain the strengths and weaknesses of each source, considering its usefulness and reliability and the reasons it was valuable to the project and the central argument of the project (*Remember ADAM ANT*).
