- child soldiers
- abuse of children
- torture
- capital punishment
- capital punishment
- arbitrary detention
- religious discrimination
- discrimination against women
- exploitation of workers
- human trafficking and slavery
- limitations on free speech.

### **You will need to conduct an ICT based report upon your issue using the following suggested platforms:**

- Google Slides
- Sway
- Prezi
- Other (seek teacher permission first)

### **Things to consider**

- When presenting your Human Rights issue you will need to introduce and discuss in detail the legal and non-legal responses towards your issue.
- You will also need to show development of the legal response and your evaluation of the effectiveness in resolving your selected contemporary issue.
- The presentation time is to be **no longer than 7 minutes.**
- **Monday 29/3/21 - Week 10** You are to print off your completed presentation plus supply a USB (containing a digital version of the research task) and submit it by **9am** (in the library) Presentations will be conducted throughout Week 10.

- **Absences:** If you know you are going to be away on the day that the task is due, you must make alternative arrangements with your teacher beforehand. If you are suddenly away on the day that the task is due, you must contact your teacher or Head Teacher on your return to school. Documentation will be required in both cases
