#### **Multiple choice**

These questions will be a mix of geographic skills and content. With the skills questions, the interpretation of a broadsheet will be involved. Geographic skills will include:

- Mapping
- Latitude and Longitude
- Infographics
- Grid References
- Area References
- Cardinal Directions
- Climate graphs

#### **Short answers**

These questions will be on the topics of Landscape & Landforms and Place & Liveability. Be sure to review your earlier assignments and your lesson work.

#### **Outcomes to be assessed:**
