Assessment Outline

Photostory - Self introduction

Instructions:

- 1. Look at the example script in your booklets/Google Classroom and the marking criteria
- 2. Ensure you <u>include all necessary information</u>, <u>all grammar structures</u> are correct and that your <u>pronunciation is</u> <u>natural</u>.
 - To do this, **double check your sentences**, and **listen to the sample Photostory many times**, mimicking the pronunciation. Have a peer check your pronunciation before you submit.

Ensure you revise the following:

- Basic greetings
- Saying your name
- Giving your phone numbers
- Saying ages
- Saying nationalities and the city you come from
- Talking about where you live
