Part A

Part B

Use the information from Part A to record an introductory video that you could send to a potential exchange student from a German-speaking country. You will be marked on your pronunciation, rhythm and fluency.

Non-completion of Task:

If you are suddenly away on the day that the task is due, you must contact your teacher or Head Teacher on your return to school. Documentation will be required in both classes.
