- **Financial Mathematics** – Quantity as a Percentage, Percentage of a quantity, Percentage Increase and Decrease, Unitary Method, Percentage Profit and Loss, Salaries and Wages, Overtime, Commission, Piecework, Annual Leave Loading, Tax Deductions, Taxable Income, Income tax, Tax table, Medicare Levy, Net Pay and Simple Interest
- **Expressions and Equations** – Words and Algebraic Expressions, Substitution, Like Terms, Multiplying and Dividing Terms, Expanding Brackets, Factorising and One step and Two step Equations
