### Assessment Outline

## Task Outline

**You need to do the following to complete this tasks:**

### Practical Task Week 7

- You will be caring for your 'baby egg' that you will need to take care of for **ONE** week.
- Your baby egg is a real baby! So you need to ensure that great care is taken to keep baby fed, safe, warm and protected. You need to show your teacher your baby carrier.
- Each day you will need to sign in your baby egg to daycare **before the first period.** You also need to **collect your baby after period 6 (3:30)** from your teacher and sign your baby egg out of daycare.

### Theory Due Week 8

- Your baby egg needs to be brought to school with you each school day and participate in all family activities on the weekend. 5 entries need to be completed in your journal with photos of 'baby egg' participating in activities- mealtimes, night time routine, play etc. The Journal is attached to the google classroom for you to complete.
- You need to create a birth certificate for your baby.
- You need to document the birthing experience.
