Here is a breakdown of the exam. Multiple Choice: These questions will be a mix of historical skills and content. With the skills questions, the interpretation of Primary and Secondary sources will be involved. Short Answers: These questions will be on the topic of Changing Rights and Freedoms and Popular Culture. Be sure to review your earlier assignments and your lesson work. One Longer Response: This response will be closely linked to your studies of Popular Culture, make sure that you review specific examples such as: music, films, television and sport.

### **Non-completion of Task:**
