ASSESSMENT OUTLINE:

In class students will complete an End of Course Examination. There will be three parts.

- 1. Geographic Skills. This will be multiple choice using a broadsheet.
- 2. Water in the World. Short answers on various aspects of water, such as natural process and how human beings use water for our purposes.
- 3. Interconnections, specifically the Tourism Industry. Four short answers using some visual graphics on tourism statistics.
