Assessment Outline

In Week 5 you will sit your yearly English exam. This exam contains two parts:

Part 1: Multiple Choice questions (10 marks) - 10 mins

- This will assess your knowledge of film genres, camera angles and techniques, and cinematography.

Part 2: Extended Response (15 marks) - 30 mins

- You will write an extended response about the director you studied this term and analyse what makes their style distinctive. You will use a scaffold to prepare your response and you will be able to use your plan during the exam to help you develop your response.

Non-completion of Task:

If you choose not to complete the scaffold before the deadline set by your teacher, then you will have to complete the extended response without your plan. You will be provided with a blank scaffold to help you in the exam.

If you know you are going to be away on the day that the exam is scheduled, you must make alternative arrangements with your teacher beforehand. If you are suddenly away on the day of the exam, you must contact your teacher or Head Teacher on your return to school. Documentation will be required in both cases.

Failure to follow the above procedures may result in a zero award.
